- SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment FISH 403F

On April 30, 2007 I conducted an assessment of FISH 403F at the **North Central Administrative Office**. This evaluation included observations of the flooring system, ceiling tiles, false ceiling plenum, environmental surfaces, interior and exterior walls, and the accessible ventilation equipment. Additionally, environmental parameter measurements were taken to include temperature, relative humidity, and carbon dioxide. The detailed findings, along with the recommended corrective action can be found on the attached IAQ Assessment Worksheets.

Generally, the IAQ Assessment did not identify any existing conditions significantly impacting IAQ and thereby presenting immediate health and safety concerns to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

## Observations

#### Findings:

- Complaint of bleach odor outside of FISH 403F
- Ceiling tile in 403F was removed to do repairs earlier in the day and was put back in place at the time of the assessment
- Roof was checked and there was a recent repair done
- WD40 and a Clorox based surface sanitizer was found in the adjacent tenant offices
- Live plants in office areas

### -Recommendations:

#### Site Based Maintenance:

- Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate

## Administrative Sites Management

- Advise occupants to remove live plants
- Ensure that tenants are advised regarding chemical use
