- SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment (Occupational Health) FISH 245, 245A, 245B and 246

On August 19, 2005 the IAQ Assessment Team conducted an assessment of FISH 245, 245A, 245B and 246 at **Atlantic Technical Center**. The evaluation consisted of a walkthrough of the identified areas to assess the current condition of the location with regard to indoor air quality. This assessment included observations of the carpet, floor tile, ceiling tile, interior walls, false ceiling plenum, and accessible ventilation equipment.

Attached are the findings of this assessment along with recommendations for further assessment, remediation, or corrective actions, if needed.

Generally, the IAQ Assessment did not identify any existing conditions significantly impacting IAQ and thereby presenting immediate health and safety concerns to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

Findings: THIS IS AN OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT (EQ00473/74)

Physical Plant Operations Division:

FISH 245

- Fill two 6" holes in exterior walls to prevent vermin intrusion
- Clean wood dust from on top of ductwork
- Repair duct with torn covering
- Cut back old sprinkler pipe and relevel A/C vent
- Clean all ductwork for room

FISH 245A

- Repair rear wall and paint
- Replace 3 stained and 15 dirt impacted ceiling tiles
- Clean all ductwork for room

FISH 245B

- Repair frame for ceiling tile above teacher's desk

FISH 246 (AHU 28)

- Clean coils and ductwork
- Evaluate filter placement
- A device was installed above AHU. Bricks and ceiling tiles were removed and items are open and not sealed.
