SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment

FISH 131

On June 10, 2005 the IAQ Assessment Team conducted an assessment of FISH 131 at **Davie Elementary School**. The evaluation consisted of a walkthrough of the identified areas to assess the current condition of the location with regard to indoor air quality. This assessment included observations of the carpet, floor tile, ceiling tile, interior walls, false ceiling plenum, and accessible ventilation equipment.

Attached are the findings of this assessment along with recommendations for further assessment, remediation, or corrective actions, if needed.

Generally, the IAQ Assessment did not identify any existing conditions significantly impacting IAQ and thereby presenting immediate health and safety concerns to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

Observations

Findings:

- Brown staining visible on walls wipes off with wet paper towel. No moisture detected in walls (8%).
- Two stained ceiling tiles
- Humidity is close to high end of range

Recommendations:

Site Based Maintenance:

- Clean walls with Wexcide disinfectant solution and monitor for return of staining
- Replace stained ceiling tiles
- Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate

Physical Plant Operations Division:

- Evaluate and adjust HVAC to lower humidity level
