SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment

600 Building

On July 19, 2006 Aston Henry and I conducted a follow up assessment of the 600 Building at **Deerfield Park Elementary School**. The assessment consisted of a reevaluation walkthrough of the previously identified areas to assess the current condition of the location with regard to indoor air quality. This assessment included reviewing previously generated work orders as well as observations of the areas of concern as stated in the IAQ Assessments performed on July 19 and August 16, 2005 by Robert Krickovich. Attached are the findings of this assessment along with recommendations for further assessment, remediation, or corrective actions, if needed.

The IAQ assessment did identify one or more existing conditions impacting IAQ and has generated appropriate work orders to correct deficiencies in systems and maintenance that could contribute to decreased indoor air quality. At the time of the assessment, these concerns were not an immediate health or safety concern to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

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Findings:

- Visible microbial growth on walls throughout the hallways of the 600 Building. Custodial staff has wiped walls down several times and growth keeps returning.

Recommendations:

Site Based Maintenance:

- Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate

Physical Plant Operations:

- Evaluate cause of growth on walls and repair. Clean walls as appropriate.
- Clean duct work
