SUBJECT:	Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment		

On June 23, 2014, I conducted an assessment at Sawgrass Elementary School. Attached are findings and recommendations for further assessment, remediation, or corrective actions needed.

The IAQ assessment did identify one or more existing conditions impacting IAQ and has generated appropriate work orders to correct deficiencies in systems and maintenance that could contribute to decreased indoor air quality. At the time of the assessment, these concerns were not an immediate health or safety concern to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

Please ensure that your Head Facilities Serviceperson receives a copy of this correspondence so that the recommendations requiring their attention can be addressed. In an attempt to separate IAQ issues from general maintenance items, the attached assessment may contain direction for site based staff to generate a work order through COMPASS. Within two weeks a representative from the Custodial/Grounds Department will conduct a follow-up visit to ensure that all site based custodial issues have been appropriately addressed.

Ceiling tile is stained but dry. Roofers responded to the roof issue on the last IAQ assessment. Replace water damaged drywall under both windows and repair cause of water intrusion. Wall surfaces in restroom are dry but needs paint. Observed insect activity above drop ceiling. The left side of white marker board in classroom when entering the door has visible microbial growth, HFSP has wiped wall surfaces and microbial growth re-appears. 4 foot up from the floor and 1 foot from marker board, open wall and observe and evaluate for water intrusion.
