SUBJECT:	Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment			

On August 3, 2011 I conducted an assessment of Building 1 at Tamarac Elementary School. This evaluation included observations of the flooring system as requested by Physical Plant Operations and administration. The detailed findings, along with the recommended corrective action can be found on the attached IAQ Assessment Worksheets.

The IAQ assessment did identify one or more existing conditions impacting IAQ and has generated appropriate work orders to correct deficiencies in systems and maintenance that could contribute to decreased indoor air quality. At the time of the assessment, these concerns were not an immediate health or safety concern to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

Please ensure that your Head Facilities Serviceperson receives a copy of this correspondence so that the recommendations requiring their attention can be addressed. In an attempt to separate IAQ issues from general maintenance items, the attached assessment may contain direction for site based staff to generate a work order through COMPASS. Within two weeks a representative from the Custodial/Grounds Department will conduct a follow-up visit to ensure that all issues have been appropriately addressed.

Findings

- Request to check FISH 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 127, 137, 138, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144 for carpet issues

- Visible microbial growth on carpeting throughout rooms

- HVAC in process of being repaired

Site Based Maintenance:

-Wipe down all surfaces, furniture and equipment once HVAC system is up and running and floor tile has been replaced. -FISH 162 - Visible microbial growth on edges of tables. Site based staff to wipe down with Wexcide disinfectant solution. - Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate

Physical Plant Operations:

Remove and replace carpet with tile
