SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment

Portable 193

On October 12, 2006 Jack McDonald and I conducted an assessment of Portable 193 at J.P. Taravella High School. This evaluation included observations of the flooring system, ceiling tiles, false ceiling plenum, environmental surfaces, interior and exterior walls, and the accessible ventilation equipment. The detailed findings, along with the recommended corrective action can be found on the attached IAQ Assessment Worksheets.

The IAQ assessment did identify one or more existing conditions impacting IAQ and has generated appropriate work orders to correct deficiencies in systems and maintenance that could contribute to decreased indoor air quality. At the time of the assessment, these concerns were not an immediate health or safety concern to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

Findings: - A/C units were off at the time of the assessment

- Elevated moisture content in entire West and South walls and East wall under A/C unit
- Damaged sub-floor underneath the floor tiles
- Dust and debris on HVAC coils
- Dust and debris on HVAC supply grills

Recommendations:

Site Based Maintenance:

- Clean HVAC supply grills with Wexcide disinfectant solution
- Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate

Physical Plant Operations:

- Evaluate cause of water intrusion and repair. Remove and replace wall material as appropriate.
- Evaluate floor cavity and repair floor as appropriate
- Clean HVAC coils
