- SUBJECT: Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment FISH 517

On January 29, 2007 I conducted an assessment of FISH 517 at **J.P. Taravella High School**. This evaluation included observations of the flooring system, ceiling tiles, false ceiling plenum, environmental surfaces, interior and exterior walls, and the accessible ventilation equipment. The detailed findings, along with the recommended corrective action can be found on the attached IAQ Assessment Worksheets.

The IAQ assessment did identify one or more existing conditions impacting IAQ and has generated appropriate work orders to correct deficiencies in systems and maintenance that could contribute to decreased indoor air quality. At the time of the assessment, these concerns were not an immediate health or safety concern to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

# Observations

### Findings:

- Work is currently being done on the roof
- One stained ceiling tile
- Heavy dust and debris on HVAC supply and return grills
- HVAC return grill is not functioning properly. Temperature was low and CO2 level was elevated at the time of the assessment.

#### Recommendations:

#### Site Based Maintenance:

- Remove and replace stained ceiling tile
- Thoroughly clean HVAC supply and return grills with Wexcide disinfectant solution
- Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate

## Physical Plant Operations:

- Evaluate and repair HVAC system to increase temperature and lower CO2 level. Check drain pan.
- Evaluate and repair HVAC return grill
