SUBIECT:	Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Assessment	-			

On May 24, 2007 I conducted an assessment of Portable 845VE at **Indian Ridge Middle School**. This evaluation included observations of the flooring system, ceiling tiles, false ceiling plenum, environmental surfaces, interior and exterior walls, and the accessible ventilation equipment. Additionally, environmental parameter measurements were taken to include temperature, relative humidity, and carbon dioxide. The detailed findings, along with the recommended corrective action can be found on the attached IAQ Assessment Worksheets.

Generally, the IAQ Assessment did not identify any existing conditions significantly impacting IAQ and thereby presenting immediate health and safety concerns to building occupants. However, due to individual sensitivities and predisposing health factors, it is possible that some building occupants may elicit a health response to agents and / or conditions identified during the evaluation. Therefore, to further improve IAQ, prevent development of future IAQ-related problems, and to reduce the potential for IAQ-related complaints by building occupants, the IAQ Assessment Team recommends appropriate follow up of each item identified and listed in the attached evaluation.

Please ensure that your Head Facilities Serviceperson receives a copy of this correspondence so that the recommendations requiring their attention can be addressed. Within two weeks a representative from the Custodial/Grounds Department will conduct a follow-up visit to ensure that all issues have been appropriately addressed.

## **Observations**

## Findings:

- Teacher complained of headaches and loss of voice for the last 2 weeks
- Dust and debris on floor
- Dust and debris on HVAC supply and return grills
- Dust and dirt build up on throw rug
- Non-approved chemicals in room (Raid, Fantastik)
- Dust build up on window ledges and blinds
- Temperature was low and CO2 level was slightly elevated at the time of the assessment. Temperature was adjusted and A/C was set to exhaust at the time of the assessment.
- Restroom adjacent to room is out of work and has heavy dust and debris build up
- -Recommendations:

## Site Based Maintenance:

- Thoroughly clean and sanitize floor
- Clean HVAC supply and return grills with Wexcide disinfectant solution
- Thoroughly clean throw rug or discard
- Remove non-approved chemicals from room
- Clean window ledges and blinds
- Continue to monitor condition and initiate a work order for Physical Plant Operations to evaluate the HVAC system if temperature does not improve.
- Contact Physical Plant Operations to repair restroom and clean and sanitize as appropriate. Ensure water is run or poured in sinks and toilet regularly until repaired.
- Continue to monitor this location for any signs of microbial growth as well as dust and debris accumulation and clean as appropriate
