III. Title I Update - Ms. Pitt

I. Parents were invited to share their input regarding the development of the 20192020 School Improvement Plan, along with the Addendum and the Parent and
Family Engagement Plan (PFEP). The emphasis was placed on parents and
teachers' participation for this school year success of the plan. Ms. Pitt stated that
in March the Parent Engagement Survey was distributed to parents using two
methods, copy sent to parents' email from the Title I Office and a random selection
of students were given paper copy to take home. Unfortunately, we have 1087
students enroll and only 65 surveys were completed by email and paper-copy.
Based on the feedback from parents of the 65 survey, they strongly agree with
receiving information about the curriculum and state standard assessment, the
school communicating with them in timely manner, and felt accepted in the school.

Ms. Pitt asked for suggestions to ensure we get a larger parental support.

Ms.DeBrocq mentioned giving students a 'homework pass' to motivate them to get information to their parents. It was brought up that there is always a large turn out at sport activities and small turn out for academic nights. Ms. Mackenberg shared that giving parents free passes to sport games if they attend at least 2 academic activities. Members thought this was a good idea and we will consider it more for next school year.

II. The **Title I Parent-Compact** was reviewed, both Ms. Mackenberg and Ms. Escobar agreed that they like that we included when parent conferences are held on the document, so parents are informed early in the school year to schedule meetings. Ms. Pitt states that the Parent-Compact will be sent home on the 1st day packet like last year, as this was every effective.
