**Call to Order:** A meeting of the Hollywood Hills Elementary School Advisory Council and The Hollywood Hills School Forum (joint meeting) was held in the School's Media Center on March 12, 2019. Chair Karen Dallas called the meeting to order at 2:20 pm. Anita O'Sullivan will record minutes for this meeting.

**Minutes:** Karen Dallas motions to approve the minutes of January 15, 2019 and February 19, 2019 with some corrections. Motion to except and approve the outcome was discussed: Added to the February minutes were the attendees and we corrected two names-Tiffani was corrected from Tiffany and Mr. O'Neil was corrected from O'Neal. The minutes were read: motion to approve by Maylin Hernandez and second by Shannon Powers.

- Vote on Accountability Funds-Mr. Fossas- Today we can vote on how we will begin the proposals. Mr. Fossas would like to continue to use Vocabulary/Spelling City at our school. This can come out of the budget of the Accountability Funds. -Vocabulary/Spelling City (18 months) \$3500.00. Mr. Fossas would like to ask the board to vote to continue another 18 months contract. Ms. Dallas asked for a motion to approve and Bryan Jones made the motion to continue this item and seconded by Tiffani Joseph. The motion passed unanimously.
- What about Brain POP? Ms. Maria Babich (office staff) will get a quote to see how much it will cost the school. Ms. Vidal will ask Ms. Babich to get a quote on Brain Pop.
- SMART Bond quote update-Mr. Fossas- One item to spend money on is an electronic Marquee. There are vendors that are better than other vendors. Mr. Fossas explained some of those problems. However, there is a vendor that may do a good job. Mr. Fossas mentioned the good things that can come from using an electronic marquee versus the problems that are involved with using the non-electronic version. We will get quotes for fencing, cameras and other items and have a chance to see proposals and look at them together. Other items include a Camera and buzzer at front gate, Playground covering, Cabinets to replace stoves in classrooms, Window wraps, Chain link fence on West Side to control pedestrian traffic. Ms. Dallas asked for a motion to approve, Bryan Jones made the motion to add items and seconded by Tiffani Joseph. The motion passed unanimously.
- Principal's update- Mr. Fossas wants to wish everyone a Happy and Safe Spring Break Vacation. And to also, remind us that testing will begin shortly after the vacation-Dates to remember are April 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for grades 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> and writing on April 2 for grades 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>
