#### **OLD BUSINESS:**




#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

The School Advisory Council reviewed December's SAC minutes and Ms. Eutsey made a motion to approve the minutes with corrections into record. Mrs. Bulman seconded the motion. New Business: BCPS BEST SIP Practices- Ms. Eutsey, Co-SAC Chairperson
Mr. Jean, HCE's Co-SAC Chair was unable to attend. Ms. Eutsey explained the purpose of the
School Advisory Committee and how the SAC facilitates the development of the School
Improvement Plan (SIP). The SAC monitors the progress of the SIP and makes modifications
as needed. The agendas and meeting minutes should reflect SIP monitoring and allocation of
accountability funds. Broward County Public School enforces four BEST Practices in order
to increase student achievement. Ms. Eutsey discussed BEST PRACTICE #2- High Quality

to increase student achievement. Ms. Eutsey discussed BEST PRACTICE #2- High Quality RTI. Response to Intervention (Rtl) uses student academic and behavior information to identify students with learning and behavior needs to guarantee that those in danger of failure and/or retention are receiving assistance and support. Best Practice #2 also includes HCE's Social Emotional Plan (SEL). The SEL process is tied to BEST PRACTICE #2- High Quality RTI. There are three goals included in the SEL Plan.

\*Goal #1- Self-Awareness and Self- Management

\*Goal #2- Social Awareness and Interpersonal Skills
\*Goal #3- Decision-Making Skills and Responsible Responsible Responsible Ms. Fenton asked, "What are the teacher/student strategies aligned to SEL?" Mrs. Heverly stated, weekly strategies are included in the weekly Manatee Messages or teachers can refer to SEL videos. After reviewing the HCE's SEL Plan, Ms. Eutsey asked the SAC members do they have any input or suggestions to help make HCE's plan better? At this time, no suggestions/input was made. However, the SAC members reacted to this document positively.

Yesterday 14 out of 18 eligible classes were celebrated for earning their 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter goal. Classes are consistently working on their 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter goals. We are also celebrating literacy this week for this state-wide tradition. Friday students can dress up as their favorite storybook characters.
- Friday is also Take your child to work day. If your child will be participating, please call the front office.

Report Cards will be issued today. Regardless of what is on your child's report card, celebrate their effort!

Our students are busy! We have over 125 students in grades 2-5 enrolled in 1 of 18 TEAMs- Teaching enrichment activities to Manatees. All students in grades K-5 completed their 2nd IREADY diagnostic and progress monitoring tool, and Students in grades 3-5 completed their BSA, and FSA predictor. There are over 90 students enrolled in academic camp and we are about to expand capacity with our Language Enrichment Camp by inviting at least 40 K-3 students to participate.
