## **School Advisory Council Meeting Minutes November 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Cafeteria @ 5:30 pm**

### **I. Welcome**

The SAC meeting was called to order by Ms. Zelaya at 5:36 PM.

### **II. Approval of October 2018 SAC minutes**

The SAC minutes were reviewed for correction and grammatical errors. No corrections were made. Ms. Zelaya made the motion to approve the minutes reflecting no additional errors. Ms. Casson seconded the approval of the October meeting minutes. All SAC members were in favor to approve the October minutes at 5:38 PM.

### **III. SIP Plan: English Language Arts Goals**

Ms. Ricki mentioned how WHE is on their second year of Guided Reading. Teachers conduct small group lessons with books on the student's reading level. It's important for parents to track their child's reading level as they advance through the grades.

The small group lessons are important to get the students on grade level.

We have a consultant that teaches the teachers from K-5 on how to conduct guided reading lessons more effectively.

### **IV. Title 1 Updates**

No additional updates for Title 1. However, Title 1 provides additional funds to conduct after school activities like today's.

### **V. Principal's Report**

We have to revote on money that rolled over from last year. We would like to purchase Scholastic Magazines for K, 1, and 2. Today, we would like to vote on

spending \$3,174.96 for Scholastic Magazines. Students will get 4 magazines a month. Teachers will use the magazines in lessons (eg. Shared read aloud, guided reading, centers, etc.). Students can also take the magazines home to read to parents or create a library of magazines. The SAC committee voted to purchase the Scholastic Magazines. The vote passed unanimously.

Mrs. Clinch informed parents about the ESOL Instructional funds. The FSA camp will start on November 28<sup>th</sup>. Permission forms will outline the times and schedule for after school tutoring.

We have a campus monitor at the school. He started last week. He will be supervising the main entrance gate. We lock our car loop gate at 8:10 AM. The SRO officers will start to look at the traffic near our school more seriously.
