 - a. School Advisory Chair
 - i. Approval of Minutes →Minutes were approved (Taylor, Carter)
 - ii. Account Balance \$5876→ No word on what is left over from last SAC
 - iii. School Improvement Plan Monitoring We are writing the 2018-19 SIP. Four different sections →PLC → Response to Intervention (Our concern is College and Career Readiness)→Internal and External Relationships (Relationship within our school→Scaling Up (English/Language Arts scores on FSA have moved up)
 - iv. Accreditation Self-Assessment Monitoring How do we communicate with our students, teachers, administrators, parents, and community
 - v. Principal Security as part of the School Improvement. →interims are out today→Smooth start of the year→ This year's International Summit includes 120 students with 30 adults→SAC funds will be transferred over from last year
Thoughts from Parents about security→Seniors are complaining but it is best for them. →Seamless compare to other schools. →One single entrance is positive→Meetings: how do parents get into meetings at the school? → Event parking in faculty lot. → Security personnel was added but are still short one person. → Parent stated there should not be shortage of security personnel because taxes were raised for that purpose. → Maybe next Fall for funds to be released from the state taxes.

Student Government Homecoming Tailgate coming up on the 28th; Homecoming Dance on the 29th→Concerns - doors do not shut all the way in Mrs. Donnelly's room; Glass door in her class is close to exit→Seniors car lots and security causes students to be late. →Middle stairwell security a concern; could school open middle stairwell after A Lunch

School Advisory Forum – Izone Meetings will be held quarterly; New data platform created over two year and coming soon; Concerns about security and locked gates at other schools; locked gates mean lack of access for parents and students; no unified plan for gates; 9/26 is Take Your Child to School Day for Dads!; Broward County College Fair is 10/22 at Rick Case Arena at NSU; 2019-2020 Calendar drafts are available for comment
