- I. Call to Order 5:33PM
- II. District Advisory Council Meeting Report April 2018
  - a. Robin Bartleman, School Board Representative relayed that the SBBC voted NOT to arm teachers.
  - b. A consulting firm will be assessing all campuses for safety and security issues; recommendations are due August 18.
  - c. Next Year Midweek start Wednesday, August 15
  - d. Patrick Sipple reported on Boundary Proposals looking closely at Stoneman Douglas as 4 classrooms are using non-traditional space. Cooper City is also at capacity.
  - e. Subcommittee created by DAC reported that many schools do not have a calendar on their website; also no Canvas for many schools; a full report will be due in May.
  - f. Many complaints that legislative reports are not happening.
- III. North Area Advisory Meeting Report April 2018
  - a. Adrian Ermoli Miller, Director of Grant Writing, was the guest speaker; \$56 Billion in federal funding and 75% is left on the table; Grants cannot pay salaries or change policy or curriculum; Over \$5,000 go through District; Miller will facilitate a training workshop at PBHS on May 21, 2018; Schools cannot submit non-profit grants but PTSA can
  - b. DAC reported on Districtwide Equity Plan to ensure all students have equitable services; All schools will be required to have equity plans; Questions who gets this responsibility and do any of the initiatives replace another or just keep building on each other?
- IV. District Advisor J Council Meeting Report May 2018
  - a. Donna Boruch of OSPA reported that Stakeholder Surveys were extended to May 24
  - b. Dr. Angela Ludica of Head Start spoke
  - c. School Website Subcommittee gave their final report to OSPA
  - d. John Sullivan, Director of Legislative Affairs, discussed the 2018 Session- wrapped up with \$52 increase per student money will be utilized for safety and mental health
  - e. Constitution Review Committee Ballot Measure 6003 was discussed; it bundles 3 proposals; Proposal 10 Civic Literacy in all public school curriculums; Proposal 43 School Board Term limits to be set at 8 years; Proposal 71 School Board Governance non-elected entities can govern schools; This will be on November 2018 ballot; needs 60% vote to pass
  - f. Robert Mayerson, Commissioner from Parkland, wants DAC to consider recommending that there be no school on February 14; Feedback discussed
