Principal's Report:

-No updates on construction as there is a 6:30pm meeting scheduled for the Construction crew and district facilities leaders to give updates and answer questions.

-The FSA in Writing for grades 9 and 10 is done with the exception of the 24 students who need to complete a make-up assessment by Friday, 4/12/19 at 2:40pm as this is when the writing test window closes.

-Most of our seniors have met their ELA Reading requirement for graduation.

25 seniors are still working to meet the reading requirement by graduation

106 juniors still need to meet the requirement prior to graduation in 2020.

-Mrs. Sanon is now the AP in charge of scheduling and will handle any questions or requests for the 2019-2020 school year.

-Students should have come home with their Course Selection Cards for parent signatures required. The course selection card includes all of the new electives available per the iCAN grant.

-Dual enrollment courses will be limited next school year for Broward College, FAU, and UF students will be encouraged to take advantage of Advanced Placement(AP) courses due to budget cuts throughout the district.

-Community Partnership- The Ft. Lauderdale Police department played a charity basketball game against our State Championship Varsity Basketball team. The Police won in overtime, but our students win because the funds raised will be used to benefit the students.

-On April 24th There will be a Mental Wellness Fair for our Innovation Zone of schools which includes our feeder Elementary, middle and high schools. There will be guest speakers and ambassadors all there to promote the importance of taking care of mental health and watching for symptoms of issues.

Curriculum Updates (delivered by Mrs. Langston, SAC Secretary)

-FSA ELA Reading will take place on May 1-2 for grades 9-10

-EOC for Algebra, Geometry, Biology and History test dates are May 7-8 & May 14

-Juniors recently sat for the SAT exam and will continue to take to improve scores.

-AP, EOC, and FSA exam review remains available in Saturday camp and the students are enjoying the review. Parents are encouraged to continue bringing their students on Saturday April 13th and 27th from 8-12pm. Lunch served at 11:30am

Leadership Updates-delivered by Kamara Sanon, Assistant Principal

-PSD waiver has been approved. This means Stranahan will continue to have Personal Study Days on the first Thursday of the month for the 2019-2020 school year. The students are dismissed at 11:40am on PSD days. This will give teachers 2.5 hours each month to participate in Professional development, construct plans/monitor progress, and work to improve instructional practices. Dates were shared with parents see agenda.

Parent Question: Where can additional information about iCAN be found?

Response: Parents can always contact administration, guidance, or the magnet office. Mrs. Sanon is currently overseeing scheduling.

-There are 14 pathways that allow students to explore careers while in high school and it offers the opportunity to obtain industry certifications which will give the option to go directly into the workforce after graduation in addition to having options to further your studies. Some of our Medical magnet students recently completed the Certified Medical Assistant Training requirements and can apply for positions in this field.

Padura Asked: Are there any other questions and how can we encourage more parents to get involved?
