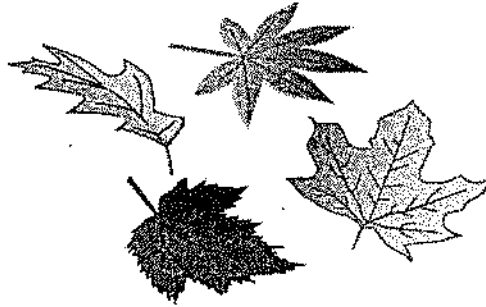

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Croissant Park Elementary SAC minutes: 8/29/18

- **Welcome and Introduction:** Regina Steinbeck called the meeting to order at 7:30am
- **Approval of Minutes:** Ms. Laing motioned to approve minutes from previous meeting held on 5/18/2018. Ms. Leville seconded the motion. Minutes were passed.
- **SAC Calendar 2018/2019:** Next meeting: Wednesday, September 12, 2018
- **SAC Composition:** The state requires 51% of the SAC committee to be a parent .The school is in need of help from parents and teachers to volunteer for PTSO.. Ms. Allison will send out a parent link or flyer to get more parents involved. Gracia Tenio and Saziye Morales were approved as new members of the SAC committee. Vote 100% approved.
- **Principals report:**
 - Safety-** There is a police officer on campus on a daily basis. Additional cameras have been installed on campus. In the cafeteria, the cameras have been upgraded to 360 degrees which allows us to see all doors. Camera is in HD. Ms. Allison stated we need more cameras.
 - Entrance-** Ft Lauderdale police does not provide a police officer. Guardianship program or city resource officer must be assigned at a school. The police are getting overtime pay to be here. A parent body is coming together quietly from neighboring schools to request that resource officers be provided by Fort Lauderdale Police Dept. Parents voted with 100% approval to use accountability funds for school safety.
 - Morning procedures-** The front office door is locked at 8:00a.m.and the back gate will remain opened until 8:05.. Car riders are cutting people off on 3rd Ave. The officer will be informed. . All classroom doors will be locked at all times. Staff will be going through active killer training soon without students on campus.
 - School Vision-** Ms. Allison will share more information at the next meeting
 - Concerns-** Front door is permanently locked, and visitors will need to show id to get through door.
- **Questions/Concerns:** Ms. Laing expressed a concern about the time students are arriving. Regina discussed late bus concerns. 8:00 in room is on time .Ms. Wong stated that it is nice to see the police car in front of the school. Ms. Wong mentioned when we have awards/parents in the morning, we could wear stickers that say “ask me about SAC/PTSO” to help generate interest and get more parents involved.
