**Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Blanche Ely High School Advisory Council was held in the Amphitheater October 16<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Spence called the meeting to order at 6:44. Steven Woloszn will record minutes for this meeting.

**Minutes:**

- Mr. Spence called the meeting to order at 6:44. He introduced the co-chair, Mr. Delvin King. The other co-chair, Ms. Butler, was not able to attend.
- Mr. Spence noted the last page, which indicates who the SAC membership needs to consist of.
- We need some additional members, i.e. Innovation Zone representative, ESOL, ESE, and Gifted. He will work on recruiting people to fulfill this representation.
- Motion to approve the minutes: B. Walker motioned, D. Robinson seconded. Vote of Aye approved.
- SMART Update. The two options from the representative from the Broward County Schools SMART Program were presented in the minutes from September.
- Mr. Spence referred to the Budget Report. There is \$4648.00 in the A+ School Recognition funds, and \$26,228.38 in the Accountability funds. There has been some shifting around this year w/ those in Budget. Connie Brown is now here on campus Tuesday and Tuesday.
- Ms. Robinson asked that we have a ballot ready to vote on at the next meeting. Also, some purchases were denied from the SMART requests.
- Mr. Spence will need to get a bottom line figure on the amount of money left so that we can decide how many laptops we can purchase.
- The Bylaws need to be voted on (every two years). The change from 2016 was the move from chair and co-chair to two co-chairs. The changes will be in effect for years 2018/19 and 2019/20.
- Shaun King motioned to accept the bylaws, Ms. Robinson seconded. Sign of Aye approved.
- New Business: Ms. Robinson shared that this year, we are not using Achieve 3000. Several departments are using USA TestPrep instead. Programs that will be purchased will include: 9<sup>th</sup> grade ELA FSA, 10<sup>th</sup> grade ELA FSA, Biology EOC, ACT English, ACT Reading, SAT Reading, SAT Writing. The cost of the programs will be \$2800. This would come from Accountability. Ms. Walker motioned to accept the \$2800

request for purchase. Mr. Shaun King seconded. Motion passed w/ a vote of Aye.

- Student question: How can we improve security on campus? Mr. Spence shared that this is a principal and a district question. Perhaps this needs to be addressed "downtown." Also, this is a SAF question; however, it was addressed during SAC.
- Ms. Walker encouraged people to become more active and push for more security. We can discuss the issue here, but it needs to go further.
- Another student question: Can we get more people to provide support for students? We are allotted as many guidance counselors as we can have. We need to have more support for when there are mental health issues and such.
- Mr. D. King asked about the process for getting more support for students. Mr. Spence shared that there are mechanisms in place for improving this. Among those are outside organizations.
- Student question on whether we can move to uniforms. Mr. Spence shared that this would be a huge undertaking. There would need to be much more support for this from parents and community.
- Ms. Robinson asked what happened in the district w/ the Black Male Task Force that was in effect a few years ago. That seemed to change to Mentoring Tomorrow's Leaders.
- Ms. Walker motioned to adjourn. Mr. Blue seconded. The group approved w/ Aye.
