SAC Minutes-October 24, 2018

Call to Order:

A meeting of the North Andrews School Advisory Forum was held in room 803. Ms. Pagel, SAC Chairperson called the meeting to order at 3:33pm. Ms. Torres will record minutes for this meeting.

Minutes: Mr. Naylor motions to approve October 3, 2018 minutes. Ms. Duhart second the motion. Motion approved unanimously to approve the minutes as distributed.

Principal Report:

1. Ms. Duhart, Principal presented information

- Gate monitor-new person, Mr. White. Monitor front entrance gate while school is in session.
 - Requesting funds from SAC to pay gate monitor, 5 hours per day. There are 130 days left in the year and request \$5,300.00 to pay the remainder of the year.
- Veteran's Day Lunch-flyer sent home to the community on 10/24/18 to announce a special lunch we are holding on November 9, 2018 for all veterans (in community and at school location).
- Accelerated Reader Computer Software Program- Purchased for 4th and 5th grade students.
 - Requesting funds from SAC to purchase more licenses for 2nd and 3rd grade students in the amount of \$2,553.00
- SAC's budget- currently has \$4,371.00 allocated for teacher/other and \$4,222.48 for supplies.
- I-Ready ELA Discourse Cards- Literacy coach is requesting English Language Arts (ELA) cards from I-ready to supplement our reading curriculum.
- Science Night at NAGE- We will be hosting a Science Night on Jan. 15, 2018. It has already been paid for and it will contain approximately 20 different science-based learning centers for parents and students to enjoy.

Mr. Naylor requested that the money amount requested from SAC be put in writing and emailed to all committee members. He would also like to confirm that SAC can use money from their funds to pay for a gate monitor.

- Parents agree that they like having a gate monitor and would encourage us to keep someone at the gate during school hours.

New Business/Open Agenda:

1. **2018-2019 School Improvement Plan (SIP)**- Our goal is to increase English Language Arts (ELA) by 3% in testing grades.
Our goal is: 55% proficiency in ELA (grades 3,4,5), 63% proficiency in Math (grades 3,4,5) and 53% proficiency in Science (grade 5).

Broward's Standards Assessment (BSA)

- We will be using Broward Standard Assessment (BSA) to monitor our students' progress toward achieving this goal.
- BSA done on computer even though the Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) is going to be paper based this year.
- BSA window mid-year around Jan. 8-Feb. 8, dates will be forthcoming

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2. **FACE plan- To work collaboratively with families, community members and schools to ensure student success.**
 - Our school will use "Panther Grams" to recognize positive teacher behaviors.
 - Copy of the plan and Panther Grams were provided at today's meeting.
 - The behaviors of excellence for Panther Grams was explained.
3. **School Advisory Forum (SAF) By Laws:**
 - Mr. Cunningham and Ms. Dudio are the designees that will attend SAF meetings and discuss any concerns.
 - To vote we will need a quorum.
 - Relations between the School's Improvement Plan (SIP) and Community involvement (SAF).
4. **Skyla Ballard-Parent presented information**
 - Children's Harbor-would like to bring in a guest speaker to come the January SAC meeting to discuss a free program that is available to help the school and community with in home counseling and therapy.
 - **Place on agenda to discuss at the next meeting because she originally wanted to come in December but SAC doesn't have a meeting in December.**
