Reward Schedule: Once per month, a name will be selected and the staff member will be acknowledged for their accomplishments here at our school. The staff member will have their picture posted and receive a small token of appreciation for demonstrating their Behaviors of Excellence.

Rules and Conditions: PANTHERGRAMS are to be given to those staff members that go above and beyond with their customer service and have exhibited BEHAVIORS OF EXCELLENCE in the workplace.

Who: FSA/NGSSS assessed grade levels and subjects will be assessed on the BSA at schools that participate, schools must complete the survey below (copy and paste link below) by **November 9, 2**

When: Schools choose dates within the **January 8, 2019 – February 8, 2019** assessment window.

How: The BSA will be administered entirely on the computer to provide immediate and actionable results through the Gauge testing platform.
