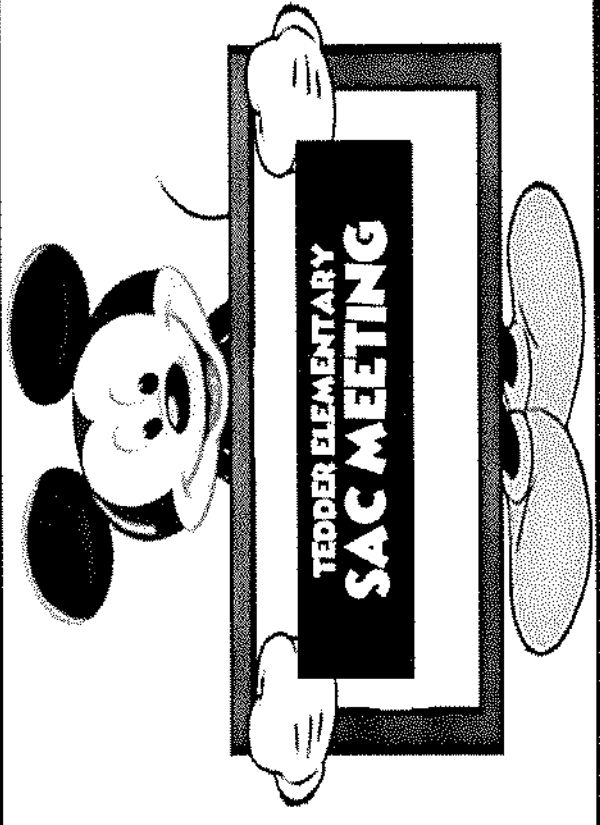

Elementary Reading Scholarship:
District Scholarship is available for ESOL/ELL students. Forms for the scholarship went home today. Scholarship is for \$500 for tutoring services. All eligible third, fourth, and fifth grade students received an application.

Parent Night:
