A meeting of the Sunland Park Academy's School Advisory Council and School Advisory Forum was held in the media on Thursday January 19, 2019. SAC Chair, Helen Kassim called the meeting to order at 5:25 pm. The quorum was met therefore the group was able to vote on agenda items. SAC Secretary, Greer Robinson recorded minutes for this meeting.

**Minutes:**

A motion to approve the minutes from our November 29<sup>th</sup>, 2018 SAC meeting was called by Ms. Kassim. Mr. Harmon motioned for approval and Mrs. Maxine Brivitte the approval of the minutes with no corrections required.

**Old Business:**

1. School Improvement Plan has been accepted and will be forwarded to Title 1 for submission as required.

**New Business:**

1. SAC Composition and SAF designee
  - The floor was opened again for SAF designee nominations
  - No nominations were made
  - At this time Ms. Ragin will continue to fill in as SAF designee until one has been appointed
2. BSA
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be taking the Broward County BSA assessment on January 28<sup>th</sup>
  - The test will last 4 days
  - The parents were given a brief description of what the BSA is and how we use it as a tool to prepare the students for the FSA. The students will be expected to use all of the strategies they have learned.
3. School Safety
  - The safety team has come out and assessed the camera system. The suggested upgrades have been submitted for approval. Various cameras will be strategically located to ensure needed updates to the school are in place to help us meet the new safety criteria. They are equipped with 360 turns and are digital systems linked directly to BSO for a live feed in case of an emergency.
  - A sign has been posted and you must knock for entrance to the building. We utilize one point of entry for all visitors.
