- A meeting of the Bayview Elementary School Advisory council was held in the Mattie B. Pollack Media Center on January 10, 2019. Mrs. Stephens, SAC chairperson, called the meeting to order at 14:19. Mrs. Larkin will record minutes for this meeting.
- Minutes

Mrs. Green motioned to approve the minutes of 12/13/2018 .

- Administrative Report was given by Mrs. Frost
 - The school has instituted new programs for student achievement. Comparisons have been made between beginning and mid-year and there is a noticeable improvement in student performance. Teachers feel i-Ready is useful and effective.
 - School Security: All exterior gates and front door to the office remain locked. All staff and students have ID badges and are required to wear them at all times. Perimeter of the school is now secure with fencing. Everyone that is present on campus must participate in school drills. Each classroom will have a designated safe space in the room. The district meets periodically to discuss and update administrators on new safety policies. The State of Florida has a fire code specific for schools and the district is required to follow the guidelines.

Currently there are \$3,578.70 in the ELOP funds. There were several suggestions on how the funds should be used.

- Monthly multicultural awareness programs
- Webcams for kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade to make i-Ready login easier
- Stipend to Ms. Pfeffer for assisting with ELOP
- Stipend to SAC Chairperson

Motion to use the ELOP funds by Mrs. Stephens was unanimously approved by the members present.

Best Practice 3 of the school improvement plan was presented (Internal/External Relationships) There were concerns in reference to editing needed regarding teachers not coming to meetings prepared. Mrs. Stephens will discuss with school-based team leaders and present changes at February's meeting.

- Best Practice 4 of the school improvement plan was presented. Several steps are in place to assist with student learning gains.
 - There will be a focus on the lower 25% for learning gains.
 - FSA camp will be incorporated to assist with learning gains.
 - Discussions of data and standards
 - Quarterly data chats
 - Administration and support will assist with monitoring students
 - CPST meetings
 - Using balanced literacy
 - Increase the percent of students earning a 3 or higher on the ELA FSA
- Barnes and Noble has a 25% discount every weekend for educators.
 - Next meeting to be held in the Mattie B. Pollock Media center on February 7, 2019.
 - Meeting adjourned at 2:40 by Mrs. Stephens. Motion carried unanimously.
