- Gifted –

    - The Gifted Advisory Council members are up for reelection. If they do not find parents to take over these roles the Gifted Advisory Council gets rolled back over to ESE. Information should be on their website or Facebook page on how to attend the next meeting.

- Change in SAC time for next year discussed to try and increase SAC attendance, possibly at 5pm
  - Funds
    - SAC funds roll over to the next school year.
    - Money not used by teachers in their Classroom Supply Assistance Funds will roll back into the schools SAC.
    - Funds need to be spent based on SIP plan – enrichment and remediation.
    - Request of funds to help purchase certificated for honor roll ceremonies.
    - Ideas of fund expenditures could be for incentives or supplies for Saturday school or afterschool tutoring, or extra supplies for students. For example, backpacks.
  - NAEIR – non-profit donations given and people can shop for supplies as a large discount.
