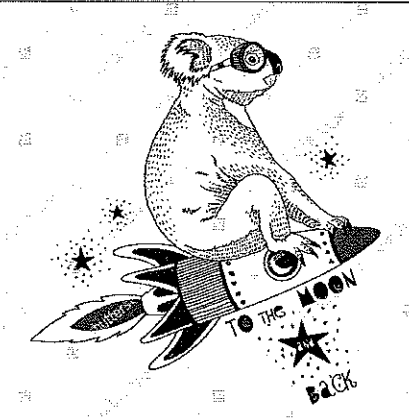

SAC Minutes - 1/31/19

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## Attendance:

## Call to Order:

A meeting of the Cresthaven Elementary School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center on 1/31/19. Chair Denise Camuto called the meeting to order at 2:35 PM. Denise Camuto will record minutes for this meeting.

## Minutes:

- Mr. Lee welcomed member and guests. He shared BSA data for students in grades 3/4/5, explaining that these scores can be used as predictors for the FSA scores as well as a tool for assessing student needs and differentiating instruction.
- He noted that grade 3 scores remained about the same while grades 4/5 showed progression toward increased proficiency.
- Mr. Lee then addressed how we are working in the Primary Grades (K-2) to move students toward proficiency. He explained that in addition to Accoletics (for 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade) we are also actively working with the standards to make sure that we are teaching to the rigor of the standards.
- Ms. Heavner spoke next and discussed how CRE is beginning Saturday School for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students on 2/2. This is being offered to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students who scored poorly on the BSA and will work on reading and math skills. She added that Saturday School for 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> grade will begin in March.
- Ms. Heavner asked if anyone had questions/comments or concerns and none were forthcoming.
- Mr. Lee took the floor once again took the floor. He spoke on school safety and gave an overview of some of the changes that are being made.
  - Cameras in all areas / perimeter covered
  - District livefeed into schools
  - New dismissal plans as recommended by safety commission has been implemented limiting access to campus
    - Ms. Borrero brought attention to fights that have been occurring OFF CAMPUS after dismissal. Mr. Lee communicated that we are not permitted to follow students off campus but will address it with Deputy Chisolm.
    - Ms. Rosado feels that dismissal is not safe for walkers – parents cannot see who is taking the children as they come out gate. Explanation given that “walker” meant that a student was dismissed at end of day free to leave campus. If a parent was picking up, that is their choice; we are following plan as recommended by safety commission.

## Open Agenda

Mr. Lee opened floor for questions/concerns/input:

- Mr. Borrero asked if curriculum provides for training/teaching to meet requirements of BSA/FSA – Mr. Lee explained standards alignment and curriculum. Also noted that we are planning standards informational meetings as well as homework help for parents as part of next year's SIP.
- Mr. Borrero addressed Mr. Lee with questions regarding the position of parents who happen to be Law Enforcement Officers and what is the position of the school regarding being armed on campus. He noted that in the past his directive was to stand down and be a witness. That has changed subsequent to the MSD incident to be “attempt to stop the threat”. Wants to know School Board official position. Mr. Lee

explained he does not think that it is written and Mr. Borrero should communicate with his superiors regarding directives. Mr. Borrero indicated he would do that during an upcoming training.

- Question was raised – “what happens if code red while parents are in the building and they don’t know what to do”? Mr. Lee will look into protocol for code red with parents (possibly have code red drill during a SAC meeting).
