April 16, 2019–8:00 am

Welcome/ Role Call to Establish Quorum:

Mr. Duverneau welcomed everyone to the SAC meeting and commended them for attending monthly SAC meeting.

Approval of Minutes:

Mr. Duverneau read the minutes and they were approved by Mr. Pierre and second by Ms. Mosley.

Highlighting Successes:

Mr. Duverneau shared slides about student of the month breakfast, award assembly events, Waste Management event, After School Clubs, Game Day and Rocking BG's (Boys and Girls) quarterly celebration.

Principal Updates:

Mr. Gibson informed the committee that FSA testing will start on May 1, 2019. He also spoke about how administration and teachers have utilized all resources and strategies to meet the needs of all students to get them ready for the FSA test. Mr. Gibson briefly spoke about students must meet promotion criteria to go to next grade level. Parents will receive a possible retention letter for students who are in danger of failing. Flyers will go home with each student regarding the FSA test. Mr. Gibson want parents to continue working with their student at home, as this will help teachers prepare the students for the FSA test.

Parent Involvement Allocation:

Mr. Gibson talked the proposed allocation of public school dollars/funding and how it may affect Public Education for the upcoming school year 2019-2020. The committee was asked about suggestions on how funds should be used for parent involvement activities. All members agreed Title I fund allocations for Palmview will be used for the following: materials, food for parent involvement nights/events, Saturday camps and agendas for each students.

Summer School:

Mr. Duverneau stated that summer school will be held at Sanders Park Elementary. Summer school will be for retained 3rd grade students only. Retention is mandatory by the State once a student reaches the 3rd grade.

Mr. Duverneau reviewed 2018-2019 School Improvement Plan and its entirety. He explained the importance of having a School Improvement Plan, where to locate it, and provided each member a hard copy of Palmview's final School Improvement Plan. Every year SIP is updated to reflect any changes.

They discussed how the school can improve parental involvement. The committee decided to have bilingual volunteers to communicate or translate for our Haitians and Hispanics parents.
