Minutes

January 14, 2019

Meeting called to order at 3:15p.m.

Mrs. Smith opened the meeting and stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss how to spend 2018 A+ funds. She offered the A+ proposal from 2016 as a guide. The previous year granted \$1000 for student incentives and every staff member an equal share of the remaining balance. Employees who worked 50% of the time were given 50% of that share. She then opened the floor for suggestions and distributed a copy of the previous A+ proposal as a reference. She reminded the committee that the funds are less than they were in the 2016 proposal.

The committee reviewed the proposal.

Ms. Coke-Malcolm suggested that the 2018 proposal also include the entire staff (teachers, assistants, office staff, custodial, and cafeteria, parent educator).

Mrs. Smith stated that the proposal would be presented to staff by Wednesday, January 16, 2019 with a final vote on Tuesday, January 22, 2019.

Ms. Phillips suggested to add an attendance rate criterion of 90% all faculty and staff who returned for the 2018-2019 school year to the proposal. All agreed. Ms. Coke-Malcolm made a motion that all of the A+ funds be equally distributed among all faculty and staff and provide approximately \$1,000.00 for student incentives. Ms. Lamar seconded. The motion was passed.

Mrs. Smith stated she will prepare the proposals with the changes voted on by the SAC committee and present to the staff on Tuesday, January 15, 2019.

Principal's report is deferred until the next meeting.

Meeting was adjourned at 3:55.
