Minutes from the August 2, 2018 meeting were reviewed and approved.

SIP Plan-Reading and Math Goals were presented to the group. The September iReady beginning of the year diagnostic test produced data that supports the Reading and Math iprovement goals for grades3- 5. Students are working duirng "Intensive hour" daily on Reading skills. Students are pulled into groups for assistance with Math standards.

Mrs. Leverett the Title I Liason for North Fork Elementary explained the purpose of Title I. Mrs. Winston explained "What is Title I and How does it works?" The Parents Rights and Parents Rights to know were explained. Parent Trainings will be offered throughout the year. The Title I funds are based on the SIP and SAC helps to determine how the funds are used. Partnering with Parents and the school will help the students succeed. Family/ Parent engagement plan was discussed because it is the very iportant to student success. A list of tips was given on how to support your child's education.

Principal's Report: Ms. Amaker explained the changes in Safety and Security as a result of the Stoneman Douglas incident. Armed guard will monitor the campus during school hours. (7:30AM- 4:30PM). The gates of the school are locked from 8:00 AM- 2:00 PM daily. Visitors must call the school for the gates to be opened. A sign will be placed on the gate with instructions and the front office number. During discussion, Mr. Fagan asked if the school could send out a parent link to inform parents about the new security procedures. Ms. Amaker siad that she would send out a parent link in addition to the letter (messege from the superintendent) as soon as possible. She reminded the group that RED RIBBON week is October 22-26, 2018. Students will participate in drug prevention activities during that week and a newsletter will be coming home with details.
