Best Practice # 2 : An embedded high Quality Rtl Process

- Rtl uses student academic and behavior information to identify students with learning and behavior needs to guarantee that those in danger of failure and/or retention are receiving assistance and support
- Rtl team members include: Classroom teacher, Literacy Coach, Guidance Counselor, Administrator, School Psychologist, School Social Worker, ESE Specialist, Speech Pathologist (when needed), Parent
- Assessment data (FSA, Quarter grades, BAS), Progress Monitoring Plans and other forms of identification is used to determine specific instructional needs and interventions for students.
- Intervention is implemented based on individual student's needs. Intervention presently in place
 - Phonics for Reading
 - I Ready
 - Classroom small group instruction
 - Leveled Literacy Intervention
 - Math special for grades 3-5
