I. Welcome 5:20

Mr. Forbes calls the meeting to order and welcomes Dr. LaCasse to present the Principal's Report.

II. Principal's Report 5:21

Dr. Lacasse thanks everyone for being at the SAC/SAF meeting and says that the school is running fine.

- A. Graduation will be May 31st in the morning. Each student will be allotted 6 tickets but is not allowed to sell unused tickets to their peers.
- B. Ms. Jones has sent out a temporary list of Dates to Remember for the next couple of months.
- C. Nova has hired a new family therapist who is doing great things for the school. The school used to have four to six Baker Acts per week. We have yet to have one since she joined us.
- D. Tomorrow (Friday, February 1) is Take Your Child to Work Day. The school is expecting to have low attendance.
- E. Girls Varsity Basketball goes to the Big 8 Tournament tonight with a 20 and 2 record.
- F. Dr. LaCasse introduces Nova's new SRO, Officer Green, from the Davie Police Department. Officer Madias has been promoted to detective with the Davie PD.

III. Adopt October and November Meeting Minutes 5:34

- A. Mr. Forbes notes that quorum has been met to adopt last month's meeting minutes. Ms. Cerone says that there is only one "r" in "Cerone" and not two, as spelled in the October meeting minutes.
