1. Welcome

- Ms. Matias welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Approval of the minutes from the December 4, 2018 meeting.
 - Ms. Desai motioned the minutes and Ms. Rung seconded the minutes.
- 3. School Improvement Plan
 - ELO camps and FSA Crunch-time are beginning to get started.
 - Teachers are getting ready to begin data chats with students to review FSA and iReady Data.
 - Mrs. Phillips discussed our school improvement and gains made in iReady from September to December, which looked very promising. Students are expected to be using iReady at least 45 minutes per week.
 - FSA Testing will begin in May this year. All 6th grade testing is paper-based, 7th & 8th grade is computer-based. This may cause a delay in receiving scores.

4. SMART Bond

- Renovations will begin in July, 2019.
- Ballot will be created for next meeting to vote on which 2 options will be voted on to
 use for the bond. Eligible voters will include parent votes (1 parent vote per
 student), teacher votes, and any registered school volunteers.
- Smart Bond proposed expenses: Marquee, Sound System in Gym, New floor in Gym, Gym bleachers, cafeteria tables, teacher chairs, Kiva chairs, student desks, front of school beautification (paint sidewalks, build up flower beds), fence décor, security shed for parking lot, broadcasting equipment, 15 laptop carts to give all SS & Science teachers, Recordex/Promethean for every classroom, Mural/Decorations Hallway signs, LCD Projectors – wireless.
- Smart Bond suggestions include: urinal wall dividers, bathroom locks/walls, water fountains, soap dispensers, fence décor, Mimeo boards, more money for textbooks/workbooks, teacher desks, keys for substitutes.

 Smart Bond Discussion SAC consensus: Sound system in Gym with wireless mic, cafeteria tables, teacher chairs/desk, student desks, Kiva chairs, Science building chairs, Science tables, Front of School beautification (paint sidewalks, fence décor, flower beds), door buzzers, front gate entrance/sidewalk leading to font office, & 15 laptop carts to give all SS & Science teachers.

5. Magnet Update

- 22 open seats for French/Chinese
- 66 open seats Spanish
- 132 open seats for Science
- Ms. Desai mentioned that additions should be made to Magnet programs to increase engagement and interest.
- Ms. Rung suggested it would be great if CLMS Robotics could possibly partner/team up with Pompano High Robotics for competitions to improve experience.
- Once students are tagged eligible (3 or above on FSA ELA & Math) for Magnet, all students are placed in lottery. Any students applying after seats filled up, students will be placed on waiting list.
