- 1. Welcome
- Ms. Matias welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- 2. Approval of the minutes from the April 5, 2018 meeting.
- Ms. Kambobe approved the minutes and Ms. Del Campo seconded.
- 3. School Improvement Plan
 - 2018-2019 school initiatives
- a. PBL across the curriculum
- b. SEL Harmony curriculum in homeroom and infused into the SPBP
- c. School Wide Positive Behavior Plan
- d. Learning stations and centers across curriculums.
- e. iReady will be incorporated into Language Arts and Math.
- f. Monitoring bubble students starting in September. Students will develop a plan with teachers regarding monitoring progress.
 - Parent input
- a. Parents were asked if they have any input on the SIP. One of the parents mentioned SEL and building this program at CLMS. We discussed that we do incorporate SEL Harmony every day during homeroom.
- Magnet Update
- a. Magnet window has opened again for the month of May. It will reopen again in June, July and August.
- b. Not all the students that applied and were accepted registered. We still need one Spanish class for the fall.

- c. Ms. Phillips and Ms. Matias presented at the MSA Conference in Chicago on Instructional Engagement Strategies for recruitment. The presentation went very well. We attended school tours and sessions focused on PBL.
- 5. Title One
 - Review 17-18 Parent Compact form for the 18-19 school year
- a. We as parents need to discipline our students.
- b. Can we incorporate BSA scores being sent home to parents to monitor. Ms. Phillips discussed that next year we will be using iReady to monitor Reading and Math scores for students. These reports will be sent home to parents.
- c. Students that received zero on the writing portion of the FSA maybe can be pulled and tested in a separate room, so they can be monitored better.
 - Review 17-18 Parental Involvement Plan for the 18-19 school year
- a. We need to make sure that we do not schedule the December SAC/SAF meeting on the first Thursday because of the Pompano Holiday Parade. We are going to schedule the meeting for the first Tuesday.

Everyone present (20 stakeholders) agreed with how we are spending the title 1 funds currently.

- Review Parent 1 survey responses
- a. The title 1 survey was reviewed. Only three questions did not show a large percentage of agree or strongly agree. These questions are Section 2 question 1. We discussed that maybe parents do not realize that students are receiving extra help in classrooms through technology-based supplements. We discussed having a parent night in September based on teaching the different types of technology programs we implement at Crystal Lake Middle School. We will have sessions held in Spanish and Creole at this event. We are also going to place these directions on the school's website for parents in English, Spanish and Creole. We could also get a banner for the fence in the front of the school about the technology used. The 2nd question that was not highly agreed upon was Section 3, question 3. Many parents did not agree that they were able to let teachers

know how their students learn best. To change this, we would like to find a better way to let parents know they can schedule a conference on their own. Perhaps a survey can be given out during open house and when a new teacher takes over a classroom they can be a survey on the bottom of the welcome letter to be returned to the teacher. Section 4, we need to specify to parents that the meetings they are attending are Title 1 meetings so that this question is answered more accurate.
