Call to Order:

A meeting of the <u>Park Ridge</u> School Advisory Council was held in the <u>Media Center</u> on <u>January 23, 2019</u>. Chair <u>Idil Oguz</u> called the meeting to order at <u>5:30 PM</u>. <u>Cherelle Martin</u> will record minutes for this meeting.

New Business:

Principal's Word:

Review of SAC's minutes:

For meeting on December 19th, 2018. Funds approved and utilized for extra lanyards and ID badges for students' safety and security.

Vote for approval of minutes on 12/19/18:

Seconded: Sherry D. Henderson

This meeting focuses on safety and security, school data, and Title 1 updates.

School updates:

Teachers are currently going through data chats to discuss how to best assist students and target specific instruction for those students. Students have recently completed BSA for 3-5, so students and teachers are working on targeted instruction and camps to assist those kids. BSA should be available by next SAC meeting date.

FSA Night will be hosted on February 7th for all parents and students. This will show parents what to be expected on the FSA, the types of questions and practices they can do at home, what the FSA is and its importance as well as resources parents and students can use at home. It is very important for parents to join in on this night.

K-2 Data chats are in progress; focusing on targeted instruction for students in primary and how to best prepare them for intermediate grades. BAS Testing is currently in progress schoolwide.

Black History Month:

Schoolwide celebration using a specific theme; Black History BINGO via WPRE, Bulletin board contests, Wax Museum, as well as Dance Team Lunchtime performances. Teachers will also host Black History research projects and learning opportunities within the classroom. Parents are invited to volunteer and assist or observe the many different activities that will be happening within the school.

Safety and Security:

Park Ridge is working to keep students alert; we will be having drills that go directly to Code RED. Park Ridge will be enacting a CODE BROWN to CODE ORANGE drill (evacuation) within the next months of school. The idea is that students will practice being as safe as needed. The Safe Haven Reports has not been released yet to principals, as a result, Mr. B does not have this information to share yet. As soon as the information is available, it would be provided to the SAC members. The Safe Haven Report is a report to suggest the safety measures for the schools within Florida.

Safety Updates/Board Updates:

Anyone within the school can call a CODE RED; Safe Spaces/Hard Corner- in the event of an emergency, students and staff will move to a safe place within the classroom/room. The identification of a safe space/hard corner will allow teachers and students to know exactly where to go in any room in the case of an emergency based on the recommendations of our SRO, and the Safe Haven reports of the MSD.

SMART Bond will release approx. \$100,000 toward Park Ridge that SAC will vote on for the 2019-2020 school year. Look toward joining SAC then.

MSD Commemoration on Feb. 14:

Park Ridge intends to focus that day on learning and love. Counselors, therapists, and psychologists will be available for students and staff that day. The world will be watching BCPS and our community would like to make sure students feel safe and secure in their classrooms. Park Ridge will be asking students and staff to wear pink/red on that day to show their support and empathy for the students and families of the MSD tragedy.

Students from MSD will have an early release day; other BCPS will continue their normal schedules (excluding after school events, etc); there will be a district wide moment of silence at 10:17 AM. Security will be on high alert.
