





Mrs. Wall presented the minutes from the September 26, 2018 meeting. Jaime Adamczyk made a motion to approve the minutes. Dr. Jill Carr seconded the motion.

SAC Positions and Information:

- Mrs. Wall presented our new SAC member to the committee Mrs. Anna Middlebrooks. She has two
 children at Central Park in 2nd and 4th grade.
- Mrs. Miriam Castro is not able to participate in our SAC Committee and Mrs. Devin Murton who was
 going to be our SAF Chairperson has withdrawn her child from Central Park due to extenuating
 circumstances. She will not be able to fill this position. We will be seeking a new SAF Chairperson.
- There were two members who emailed Mrs. Wall that they were not able to attend today's meeting:
 Mrs. Kirner and Mrs. Julia Carolina Gil Cardozo.

A+ Funds:

- Mrs. Wall shared the process that must be adhered to for the A+ funds aligning to the Florida School Recognition Program.
- Mr. Bob Harms made a motion to keep the ballot the same with the following changes: correct the school year and take off the funding amount, because that information has not been released yet.
- Mrs. Wall opened the floor for discussion. Mr. Harms stressed how important every staff member's
 role is at Central Park.
- A motion was made to vote on Mr. Harm's proposal: Yes 14, No 0

Committee Updates:

- Reading: We have an iReady incentive program in place for time on task and percent correct for our students.
- Teachers are utilizing our Reading Resource Room with leveled readers and Guided Reading Short Reads.
- Math: We are having a combination Math/Science Family Night tonight. There will be games, activities, and prizes. The Scientific Method boards will be displayed and Mathnasium will be having hands-on math activities. The GO Math Program is online for teacher access.
- Science: All grade levels have created a Scientific Method board(s). Teachers and students are going
 around the school today to see all the science boards. They will be displayed at our family night
 tonight.

Principal's Update:



- Science Training will be offered to teachers on two Saturdays in November to peruse the new Science Adoption materials.
- · Parents have enjoyed participating in School Lunch Week this week.
