Call to Order

Principal – Mr. Rodriguez asked that everyone introduce himself or herself. Everyone introduced himself or herself. Mr. Rodriguez announced our teacher and staff of year Mrs. Olivares and Mrs. Ramirez. Mr. Rodriquez informed the committee that Mrs. Olivares achieved the highest score in our school's history for the Science FCAT.

Mrs. Reyes spoke about the successful Title 1 Parent night that took place on September 26, 2018. Parental Involvement Information

Mrs. Reyes shared information about the Title One Parent Annual Meeting. The dates and locations of the upcoming Title One Parent Workshops were also shared.

Parent Compact

Mrs. Reyes discussed the parent compact document and shared the importance of parent involvement. The compact form went home with the first day packet and parents were asked to sign.

Accountability Report

Budget

Mr. Rodriguez shared the school's budget that was most recently updated. He shared that most of the school's budget will be solidified after the October Full Tuition Equivalent (FTE) survey, then again during February FTE survey. Mr. Rodriguez spoke about a 5th grade interventionist that is utilized to work with a small group of students to provide assistance with getting on grade level. A fourth-grade math teacher is being utilized to support students that could move to a level 2 on the FSA. Mr. Rodriguez spoke about Ms. Pearce and Mrs. Jones pulling students in 3rd grade for Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) during the morning to provide students with a reading intervention. Hiring these support teachers using Title 1 dollars. Mr. Rodriguez spoke about 20,000 saved up from Sunshine, the afterschool program to use it for Guided Reading Training with Jane Richardson. The trainer will train teachers, work with Guided Reading Groups in the classroom and observe teachers using the Jane Richardson Guided Reading Program.

Old Business

Mr. Rodriguez talked about last year's data and learning gains. Losing positions and moving a teacher because of declines in funds. He shared the projected goals from last year and this year, learning gains and achievement proficiency. Mr. Rodriguez also discussed the calculations for receiving a school letter grade.
