### **School Recognition Funds**

\$109,726. of A+ money. Jessica explained that many different proposals were submitted. The SAC members and nonmembers were able to review all submitted proposals.

We need to come up with two options.

Last year's amount was \$103,128.

Susan Hines explained that when we are considering the ballots, that it is all about the staff and success from last year. Entire staff amount is 113 people. There are 76 people who hold the professional teaching certificate. This does not include people who are new to the school this year.

There are 40 non-certificate holding members.

Raphael suggested that would be considered to add a line to last year's proposal to add \$100 for non-certificate holding employee.

He brought up the fact that the numbers are not as high in the past and that the non-certificate holders is something more.

The county takes off 9.52% right off the top of the amount that is being divided by the staff. Staff would split \$90,232.09.

Jenee Evans makes a motion to proposal number three.

Tutorial costs is about \$4000-\$5000 per unit Reading/Math

Members were discussing how much of the money sent back to the school would impact the tutorial classes.

Motion to adjourn proposed by Sheryl Brill. Seconded by Joyce.A+

As discussed at the Nov. 26 SAC meeting, here is the language from last year's ballot:

\$10,000 of the A+ money (2016-17) will be given back to the school. The remaining money will be equally divided among instructional and non-instructional staff with an additional \$200 for persons holding a professional educator's certificate who worked at least 6.5 hours 5 days a week for 100 days to receive a full share. This staff members who worked at least 100 days but less than 6.5 hours 5 days a week during (2016-17) school year will receive a prorated share.

#### Other proposals not fully eliminated yet:

- \$10,000 of the 2017/2018 A+ money will be given back to the school. The remaining money will be equally divided among instructional and non-instructional staff with an additional \$500 for persons holding a professional educator's certificate, and who worked at least 6.5 hours per day, 5 days per week for 100 days. Those staff members who worked at least 100 days but less than 6.5 hours per day five days per week during 2017-2018 will receive a prorated share.
- ...Distributed equally among all staff and faculty which includes office staff, custodians, cafeteria staff, support staff, administrators, paraprofessionals, and speech and language pathologists, after \$10,000 have been allocated to the school.


