ASSIST Stakeholders Survey-

We are the only school in the area that has met all the targets. We needed 214 student surveys and have 313 student surveys completed. We needed 67 staff surveys, and we now have 88 completed. For parent surveys, we needed 127 completed and now we are at 138 completed.

We should try and educate parents and teachers about the school website and all the information available to them under the SAC/SAF tabs. Mrs. L. Diaz worked with Mr. Boehm to have it included on our website, such as important dates, SIP, and SAC Bylaws.

Per SAC Bylaws, we need a nominating committee of at least 3 members for new positions that become available. The position for Gifted Rep. will be open next year. We need to advertise the opening for SAC using all forms of communication and post on the school website.

BTU News

Florida Legislature is in session and taking all bills to vote on. Bond money may be divided between public school teachers, private school vouchers and charter schools. The voucher will be funded directly from general revenue, further depleting the funds available for public schools.

# BSA Results/ Language Enrichment Camp/ FSA Camps:

met with 3, 4, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade teachers to look at results and plan ahead. Going to meet with primary now. Predicted Proficiency 2018 to 2019:

Reading 49.1% to 57.2%

Math 51.1% to 63.5%

Science 39.8% to 56.4%

3rd grade went down in reading compared to  $3^{rd}$  grade last year.  $3^{rd}$  grade will do reading FSA camps this year and 4th and  $5^{th}$  will do math. Inviting low level 3's and high 2's.

Try to make ESOL groups no more than 12 kids per group. It is funded through Title 1 funds from the district. It is one group per grade level.

Camp for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will start earlier since their testing starts earlier. Paper for consent should go home this week.

#### **Safety and Security:**

Just met and we are getting 10 new cameras.

4 cameras will go behind 3<sup>rd</sup> grade building.

2 cameras will go in the cafeteria.

1 camera will go by the primary playground.

1 camera will be out by the back loop.

1 that will see the basketball courts and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade building.

Survey was done by Ms. Morgan about the radios we use.

Buzzer- money is ready. Ms. Morgan is calling weekly to find out about the status.

Cameras should be ready by next year.

Discussed dry wall – the office is very open to the courtyard.

SIU just met with staff regarding procedures.
