

Additionally, the school will analyze the effectiveness of the Professional Study Days based on the impact on student achievement to determine whether to continue the waiver as is, adjust the number of days being requested, or to discontinue the waiver.

The majority of the allocated time during pre-planning days will be spent on District mandated programs, including Marzano's Framework of Teaching and Learning Model, Common Core Implementation, Suicide Prevention, Anti-Bullying and Violence Prevention Programs and our school- wide initiatives, which include, but are not limited to: writing across the curriculum, standards-based literacy instruction, data analysis, development of common formative assessments, Instructional Focus Calendar development, technology roll-outs, CANVAS implementation, and data team roll out. By the addition of study days, our school will have additional hours for professional learning on early release and planning days. Adequate additional time is necessary to allow educators to continue unwrapping the state of Florida Standards, as well as prepare students for Standardized Assessments.

16. Recognizing that one strategy alone does not affect school-wide achievement, identify and explain the baseline data for the proposed waiver.

Marjory Stoneman Douglas High has a Professional Development Leadership Team in place that will assist with the Professional Study Days and to ensure quality staff development through the use of the quality review process. This team meets for one week during the summer to coordinate and develop the school Professional Learning Calendar. FSA data will be used to measure student achievement, high school graduation rate and enrollment percentages in coilege and career readiness courses (AP, Vocational, and Dual-Enrollment) and AMO Subgroups. Data will be analyzed and customer surveys will be reviewed to observe changes in school culture. In addition, all staff will be evaluated using the iObservation tool, during classroom walk-throughs, formal, and informal observations and will be provided feedback immediately by the administrative staff.
