SAC Minutes November 28, 2018 7:15 a.m.

✓ Approval of minutes from our last SAC Meeting

Review and accept minutes from last SAC meeting October 17, 2018

Ms. Leeman motioned to accept and Ms. Tobon seconded the motion. Motion passed.

✓ Aftercare Update

CAS is our aftercare provider. They've sent us packets of other providers available and we have the option of running our own/school board after care program then.

Conversation and comments:

Ms. Pontillo is fine with continuing with CAS. The only benefit for running our own is a financial benefit. We may look at/visit other schools to see how they are doing a school-run after care program. If our school were to run our own after care program a director and counselors would be hired. Parents are happy and satisfied with CAS and summer camp program.

✓ SIP School Improvement Plan – Plan submitted Oct 2018

If requested, a hard copy of the plan is available.

Review strategies (we continue what's working and add new strategies so there are some carry over strategies from last year's SIP).

Ms. Pontillo opened up the floor for questions, comments and any clarification needed.

Parent questioned if there are any parent resources to brief themselves on how to help the children that would be helpful to parents. Ms. Pontillo agreed that that is a valid point to assist parents and build home school connection with the work they bring home.

Issues with single sign-on and not being able to access all the resources available were discussed.

Discussion around all the resources being available when you are in the network from school yet at home parents are not getting all the resources available. Teachers explained that there was a major issue with SSO where we all had to reroute and enter important sites differently because SSO was down and experiencing problems.

There was a request to have communication sent home when sites aren't available or working so they are aware.

There is frustration with technology concerns throughout the district. Teachers are experiencing the same issues here at CPE.

There was a question of I-Ready as parent resource if there's a way to access the student's specific report to see how they are performed on I-Ready. Ms. Lombardo will look into this for parents. She would like to see if she is progressing and details of how she is doing. Ms Pontillo

explained that children are on individual learning paths. The next I-Ready Diagnostic is coming up December 3, 2018. We can then see if progress has been made.

An option is to have Katie from I-Ready to come out to do an I-Ready parent session to help parents with questions and concerns.

Another suggestion was that we hold another parent night to address Canvas and other online resources as support to parents.

Ms. Pontillo will work with teachers on how to better communicate and support parents with technology and online resources. Teachers are having struggles with online resources as well.
