WELCOME

- Mrs. Lawrence opened the meeting at 7:43am and welcomed all guests.
- The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

GUEST SPEAKERS

Mrs. Lawrence introduced Tanesha Johnson with Financial Partner Group. Ms. Johnson stated that her company is a new business partner with the school, and their mission is to create legacies by building financial goals.

ITEMS FOR APPROVAL

- Mrs. Lawrence requested for the council members and guests to review the minutes from the January SAC meeting for corrections.
- Changes were noted for the January meeting minutes.
- It was confirmed the quorum was not present to approve the minutes.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Reported by Mrs. Lawrence:

- These accounts are available for expenditures to meet the needs of the school.
- No funds were paid from either account and the balances remain the same as last month.

OLD BUSINESS

Discussion on the School Choice Enhancement Project (SCEP)

Mrs. Lawrence:

- Shared quotes for some items on the proposed purchase list.
- Several items are still awaiting quotes.
- The quote for the Pre-K playground includes the labor, installation, foundation and equipment.
- The District will go to leasing instead of buying printers.
- Printers purchased will be shared by 2 teachers.
- There will be a per page charge for printing.
- Wireless printers are not approved for purchase through the SCEP.
- Promethean boards are being repaired but not replaced.
- Parents need to voice their concerns for the school at the Central Advisory Council meetings.
- The budget did not allow for the purchase of I-Ready for KG and 1st grade.

Marlene Gaby:

- District approved items can be repaired or replaced.
- Cushions and pillows will not be approved as classroom furniture.

NEW BUSINESS

Reported by Ms. Greer:

- The discipline plan is due in April.
- The plan will be submitted to parents and the District.
- The discipline numbers have increased.
- Brain bucks are being used to encourage students to perform good deeds.

Reported by Mrs. Lawrence:

- Extra measures are being taken to handle threats.
- A letter and Parent Link message will be sent out on how to deal with threats.
- Students need to be mindful of what they say in school.
- It is mandated that police will be notified of all threats regardless of age or exceptionality of the student.

Title One – Parent Involvement

Reported by Ms. Mondaizie:

- A little over 100 Title One Parent Surveys have been returned.
- There were 3 parents present to represent the school at the Title One Annual Seminar.
- Students vaping in school is one of the main issues discussed at the seminar.
