- II. Approval of Minutes from January Meeting
Minutes approved motion Nicole Andrews, second Rosa Page
- III. Principal's Report – Ms. Burgess
 - Safety - There are updated school board polices emergency codes and safer spaces. Ms. Burgess reviewed them with the group.
 - They will be shared with staff tomorrow, by SIU (the school board police department)
 - Additional cameras will be installed shortly
 - Intermediate playground now being used, primary playground is closed and we are waiting on parts for repair
 - Countywide town hall meeting tonight at 6:30 pm, Tavarrella H.S.
 - Afterschool and Saturday camp are up and running
 - Science camp starting soon
 - 1 & 2 grade camps are being formed now
 - Math night February 28th Mathnasium
 - Reading night, books and blankets conjunction with Book Fair, Cafeteria will have reading night. Best practices for reading to your child will be shared with parents. Teacher readers will model appropriate questioning for parents to use at home when reading bedtime stories to their children.
 - Budget - SMART Bond \$ no update
 - COGAT Testing for 2nd grade will be March 18 & 19, we still need proctors please complete handout for proctoring if you can assist with COGAT or FSA
 - Staff Training for LIM will take place March 22nd
- IV. **Title I – Parent Input**
 - Parent Compact was reviewed and committee was asked to provide input
 - Spoke about current free and reduced lunch percentages and they are below 50%, therefore we are not sure if will be Title I next year
 - Even if we are not Title I, the committee agreed to keep the compact, it is a good tool for parent communication
 - The committee did have a suggestions for changes – they felt the compact was very detailed and complete however maybe the parent involvement opportunities could be listed and the recommendation for involvement could be worded stronger
 - - #2 add open house, kindergarten round up, Meet/Greet as places to discuss the compact– suggested by Mr. Weinbrum
 - #3 add home notes, parent communication as necessary, -suggested by Mrs. Black, Mr. Cordero, Mr. Weinbrum
 - #4 basically the times will remain the same for conferences Discussion as to if we should change the times for conferences, it was decided to leave this the same

- #5 meet the masters, at home opportunities for assistance, Mrs. Page mentioned email. PTSA involvement
- **Family Engagement Plan was reviewed and the following changes were recommended:**
 - Additional Family Night recommendations- STEM night, Technology Night, Science Night (but not with the museum- perhaps experiments?), help for parents with at home reading and math techniques
 - Continue with Open House, Mathnasium or a math night, Books and Blankets, Annual parent meeting, Rounding Up Future Leaders,
 - Conversation regarding meeting times- morning, afternoon and evening times were discussed it was suggested to vary the times at different events
 - Parent Communication has increased with the weekly phone links from the students and the accompanying e-mails and text messages, the website is up to date with the information and newsletters as well, Notebook in front office with all information and website
