

A+ School recognition funds ballot:

Guests in attendance spoke their opinion on how and why they think the money needs to be distributed. Committee members spoke their opinion on how and why they think the money needs to be distributed.

Vote for a ballot of 3 options with 6 in favor, 2 opposed, and 2 abstaining; ballot passed.

Options: a) 100% prorated to all staff. All in favor, passed.

- b) 95% prorated to all staff and 5% to classroom teachers for materials. 3 in favor, 5 opposed; rejected.
 - b) 60% for teachers 40% Non-instructional. 6 in favor, 4 opposed; passed.
 - c) None of the above. All in favor, passed.

Motion Mrs. Rego second Mrs. Shuman to approved the ballot, 6 in favor and 4 opposed.
