Location: Room 135 ~ Time 5:15 P.M.


- I. Welcome Mrs. Valentino called the meeting to order at 5:15 P.M.
- II. Previous Meeting Minutes Ms. Weber shared copies of the minutes from the previous meeting. Ms. Ojeda motioned to approve. Mrs. Dubanewicz seconded.
- III. SMART Bond Project Charter District Update District staff, Denise Williams and Tina Willard, were here and gave an update on the construction projects for the music and art rooms. They shared a presentation regarding the process and where we are in the process. We have already hired the design team and created the design. Mr. Lauar and Mrs. Moscowitz were involved in the design improvements being made to their classrooms. We are now moving into hiring a contractor to carry out the designs. The updates to each room were shown through the presentation. New HVAC renovations will be done for the Liberty Building. For more information you can visit www.browardschools.com/smartfutures and search for Liberty Elementary to get up to date information on what is happening. They asked if members in attendance had any questions. Mr. Lauar and Mrs. Moscowitz had questions about the timeline. Tina Willard replied that it depends upon the time it takes to hire the contractor. The budget allocated to this project is \$920,000 (includes all SMART bond projects, total amount that was allocated to Liberty Elementary).
- Principals Update Mr. Levine thanked the members in attendance. He and Dr. Paraiug just IV. returned from Baltimore where they received the Magnet School of Excellence Award for this school year. Liberty is the only elementary school in Broward County to receive this award. Only 8 elementary schools in Florida received this award. We finished our first round of FSA Testing, 3rd grade reading and 4th and 5th grade writing. Reading, Math and Science are coming up in May for grades 3, 4, and 5. Safer Spaces is areas designated in each classroom where students and teachers go during a code red lockdown drill. Phase 1 will begin with the classrooms that have one entry door, no windows, or windows with louver doors. Stickers will be placed on the wall indicating the safe space. Our head custodian and resource officers will be working together to identify the safe spaces. We are putting a lot of time and energy into making our school campus safety plan bigger and better. We have recently hired a new PE teacher Coach Ocasio. We are excited to have him join our team and he is currently planning field days for May. Our school is working on a big project to do inclusive scheduling. This is for our students who have IEP's, some students leave their classrooms for their services. We are looking to move towards more inclusive and streamlined support to help our students. Teacher and Staff appreciation is coming up in May and were looking for volunteers to help with this week. regards to the SMART bond, we are excited for the changes that are continuing to be made here at Liberty.
