- III. Principals Update - Mr. Levine thanked the members in attendance for their support of SAC. We are awaiting to find out if the will fund the campus monitor, if not we will continue to pay for that position from our budget. We are fortunate to continue to have two SRO's here at Liberty. One full time and one part time. We appreciate everything they are doing for Liberty. We continue to do our monthly safety drills and we will have a code red drill on Wednesday. Mr. Levine also shared that he will be transferring to another school for the upcoming year. A letter will be going home to the parents in the upcoming week.


