Guy Barmoha, Director of Secondary Learning – Discussion on Dual Enrollment: CA@BC only school in BCPS where students earn and graduate with their AA Degree. Other schools offer BC Dual Enrollment classes toward earning the AA Degree, but do not complete it while in high school. Academic integrity (doubling) and funding at high school/college discussed in detail. Two examples discussed Psychology and Algebra 2 Honors aka College Algebra. Dual Enrollment courses being limited across the District. CA@BC is NOT losing any seats. District review of budget for 2020 school year to take place over the summer and to be voted upon by School Board by December 2019.
