School Advisory Council Meeting

I. Attendance / Establish Quorum

The meeting was called to order by Dr. Jodie Weinstein at 4:03 pm. Attendance was reviewed and quorum was not met.

II. Approval of Minutes

The SAC minutes for December were not approved as quorum was not met.

III. School Improvement Plan (SIP) - Monitor

As per the SIP plan, the PSAT results were presented by Dr. Weinstein. A data sheet was distributed at the meeting. One hundred eighty-three students were administered the test.

The Best Practices for Inclusive Education (BPIE) was discussed. Thirty-three of the thirty-four indicators were already in place.

IV. New Business
