- Establish quorum and review of previous minutes Meeting began at 4:11pm. Motion to accept the minutes by Jose Hernandez and Karissa Sutton seconded.

Old Business

- o PSD waiver Dr. Bradley said there are pros and cons. Yes, we can meet with one another and get some great strategies. But then PSDs means I have less time with my students to implement those strategies.
- o Waiver vote-Roxanne Brissett made it clear that we do not have to take all 8 days. Mr. Carruth asked if wavier renewals are staggered. Ms. Brissett said they are staggered. Mr. Carruth pointed out the School Board must approve whatever waiver our school comes up with. Mrs. Brissett opened the floor up for discussion as to how many days we will take. Karissa Sutton argued for 5 as a compromise amount. Tammy Schoen argued for 4 days because we keep adding more high-stakes tests and should increase the amount of time we spend with students as a result. Mr. Carruth pointed out that the waiver allows you to have a conversation every year how many PSDs you would like to have. If the waiver is not approved, then no PSDs will take place. 22 voted in favor of preserving the waiver. 4 voted against renewing the waiver. The ballot to teachers is in two parts: 1) Are you/are you not in favor of the PSD waiver? Part 2 is how many days will be PSDs? A teacher who does not vote is counted as a "No" vote. All those in favor of changing part 2 to 4 and 6 days: It was unanimously approved.
- ❖ PTSO/ IZone Update-Ms. Nadler announced the SAT class has started, with one spot open. The ACT class starts next month, February 13th. It only costs \$250.
- ❖ Principal's Update-This February 14th has been declared a day of honor, service and love. This is in honor of the one year anniversary of the shooting at MSD. There will be a moment of silence at 10:17 AM. HOSA instructors will do a Stop the Bleed training. There will also be Yoga classes offered. There will be a remembrance walk out on the

track. Do 17 laps (4.2 miles). Write a "random act of kindness" on a paper heart. Doing some butterfly garden beautification. A lot of the students wanted to have the moment of silence in the courtyard, together as a school. Parents are advised to call students in for an excused absence, no reason needs to be given. Super Testing will be shortened days. The state has pushed the window back. They will all happen in May, that's 2-3 weeks of extra time for exam prep. There will be five days in a row, then done. Graduation will be Sunday, June 2nd at Nova Southeastern. Last year was a record, 95% graduated. Ms. Exterkamp said we have curriculum night coming up on January 29th.

The meeting adjourned at 4:43pm Jose Hernandez motioned, Karissa Sutton seconded.
