1. Call to order/Pledge of Allegiance-student led the group in the Pledge
2. Approval/Review of previous month's SAC minutes (March 19, 2019) SAC Meeting)-Florence Carter-minutes were approved by the committee from March which focused on updates of our ELO programs and input from the Title 1 Parent Compact
3. SAF Updates-Marlene Treacy-District is looking at next year and 20-21 school calendar for start dates and winter and spring break. Students will start school on Wednesday again for next year.
4. Review and feedback/discussion for the 2019-2020 Title 1 Parent Compact -Cindy Pluim-Ms. Pluim provided hard copies of the 2018-2019 Parent Compact Form as well as the new 2019-2020 Title 1 Parent Compact form that will be sent home this upcoming year. Committee approved the document and had a small discussion about some of the bullet points in parental communication and student expectations. They liked the new format on the bottom of the new compact form that allowed more space for specific signatures.

5. Review of **Annual Survey Results** and Discussion about the 2019-2020 FACE (Family and Community Engagement) Plan based on the survey results-Cindy Pluim-Ms. Pluim and Mr. Chartrand led a discussion about the findings of our FACE survey results and asked for input to update onto our **Parental Involvement Plan (PIP) for 2019-2020**. One of the areas we discussed was parents feeling that their input about their child's education was valued. A suggestion from parents was for next year, on our parent-teacher conference forms, we add a section for their input and a survey for them to take asking if they were satisfied with the conference and the discussion that took place with the teachers. These surveys and conference forms will then be analyzed each quarter by the leadership team and shared with staff at faculty meetings. The question that stated, "I often receive information from my child's school about what the school teaches my child had 72% agree and 26% strongly agree. This was a total of 98% and an increase from last year's results with this question. The committee stated that parents feel that they receive this information often this year via our website and parent link messages. They suggested we continue to use these methods and add the Remind 101 app as well. Ms. Pluim will provide a hard copy of the survey analysis in the front office for parents who could not attend this SAC meeting.
6. Principal Updates-Ms. Baugh/Mr. Chartrand -End of Year field trip and field day information was shared and will take place after all testing is completed.
