This course meets or exceeds the general requirements of NFPA 1670 "Standard on Operations and Training for Technical Rescue Incidents," Trench Rescue, Awareness and Operations Level. Regulations and standards outlined in OSHA 1926 and NFPA 1006, "Standard for Rescue Technician Professional Qualifications," Trench Rescue will be explained and applied.

This program will address:

- Scene Management and implementation of a trench rescue emergency action plan
- Collapse indicator recognition and scene safety surveys
- Atmospheric testing & monitoring, ventilation, and de-watering operations
- Shoring system construction and installation, including lumber, screw-jacks, and pneumatic systems
- Patient access, medical considerations, patient packaging and extrication techniques

Performance of all required practical skills as outlined in NFPA 1006, Trench Rescue, are necessary in order to receive a certificate. This is a performance and skill driven class; daily class times are for reference only.

Students are required to provide their own helmets, gloves, steel toe boots, safety glasses, knee and elbow pads, headlamps and/or flashlights. Personal equipment must comply with NFPA and ANSI.
