Directions to Performing Arts Center

I-95 From Broward Boulevard and points North

I-95: Exit Broward Blvd. East.

Turn right onto SW 5th Ave. Find the Arts and Science Parking Garage on your immediate right.

Or proceed straight ahead, cross 2nd St. and continue to the top of the hill for valet service.

I-95 From Broward Boulevard and points South

I-95: Exit Davie Blvd. East. Turn left at SW 4th Ave. Turn right at SW 2nd St. Turn left at SW 5th Ave. Find the Arts and Science Parking Garage on your immediate

left. Or proceed up the hill to the right for valet service.

Federal Highway (US1)

Turn onto Broward Blvd. West. Turn left onto SW 5th Ave. Find the Arts and Science Parking Garage on your immediate right. Or proceed straight ahead, cross 2nd St. and continue to the top of the hill for valet service.

No chewing gum, food or drinks in the center.

Tickets

Each graduate will be issued four (4) tickets. Every guest of ANY age must have a ticket.

Students can request up to 2 additional tickets by writing Mrs. Kefford a typed letter, detailing how many tickets are being requested (up to 2) and who the tickets will be used for.

Letters will be accepted from March 21st through the 25th. NO LETTERS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER MARCH 25TH.

Handicapped seating/special assistance requires advance notice. Please advise Mrs. Kefford at least two weeks prior to the ceremony.

Parking

Parking restrictions and fees will be announced at the first graduation rehearsal.

Final Notes

Your Guidance Counselor is the key to your walking across the stage. Make sure you have reviewed your Graduation Eligibility with your counselor well before the big day arrives!

No seniors will be allowed on campus after May 27, 2011 unless for graduation rehearsals. Once the rehearsals, graduates must leave IMMEDIATELY. Failure to do so will be deemed as trespassing and participation in the graduation ceremony could be revoked as a result.

Service Hours!

Make sure you have met the Service Hours Requirement. Service Hours are due by April 1, 2011.

***You cannot graduate unless you have 40 documented service hours.**

We will distribute a **letter from the Superintendent** that addresses graduation and the expected conduct at the event. Your parent, as a condition of

participation, must sign the letter for you to participate in the event. It will be distributed in May.
